www.cces.ca/canadian-anti-doping-program**POLICY:** Calgary Blizzard Soccer Club (CBSC) shall adhere to Canada Soccer Association's (CSA) anti-doping policy which has been created in conjunction with CCES and the CADP. CBSC shall educate coaches, players and parents about this anti-doping policy through staff/volunteer meetings, player/parent meetings and CBSC policy manuals.**INTERPRETATION** The CCES is the custodian of the CADP which are a set of rules that govern anti-doping in Canada. The CADP consists of several components such as in- and out-of-competition testing, education, medical exemptions, and the consequences of doping violations. The CADP is compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code and all international standards. CSA has adopted the CCES and CADP which means that CBSC is a part of a world-class anti-doping program that is designed to protect athletes' rights and ensure a level playing field. CSA's anti-doping policy reflects and supports the CADP.
